**Varberg** is known for its thriving technology community. The city boasts innovative companies, advanced manufacturing, and a strong emphasis on fossile-free energy solutions.

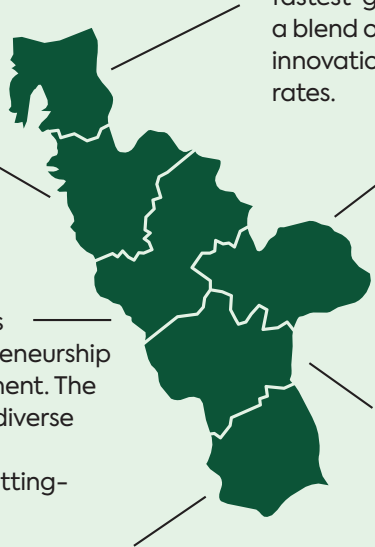

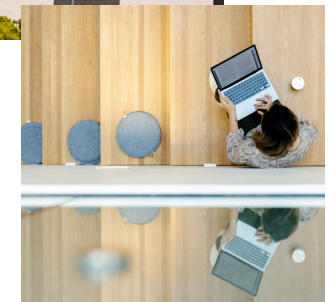

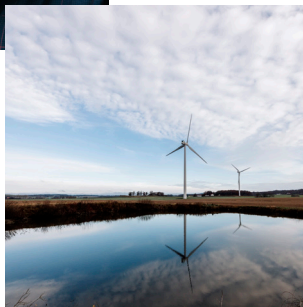

## Halland - A commuting region

Halland has strong connections to large and expanding job markets, especially with Gothenburg and Mölndal. Almost 23,000 people commute to Gothenburg and Mölndal from Halland, while 6,100 people commute to Halland from there. Additionally, there is significant commuting activity between southern Halland and Skåne.

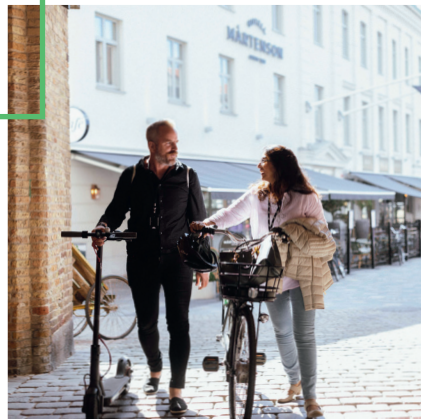

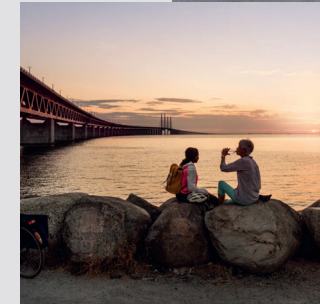


## Greater Copenhagen region

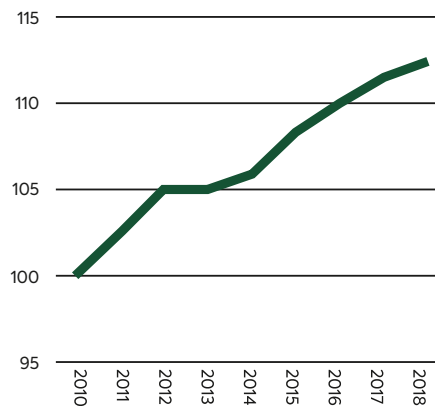

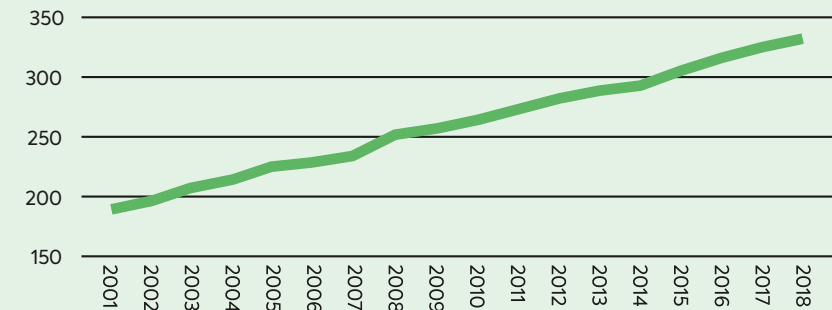

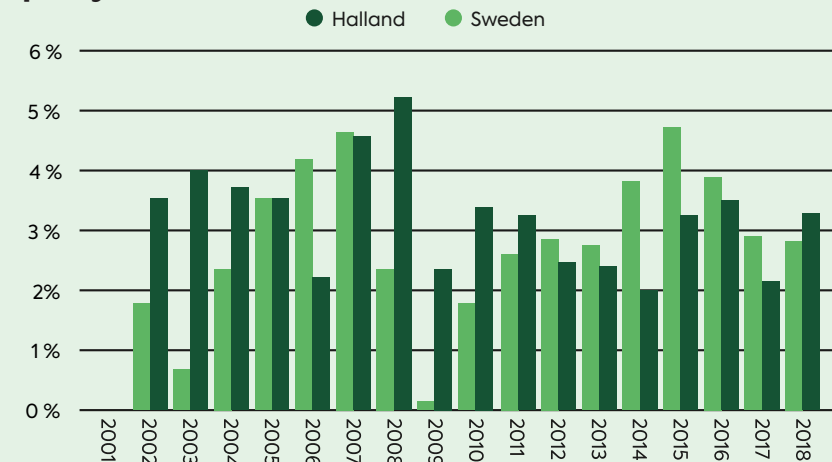


## Wage expense per employee

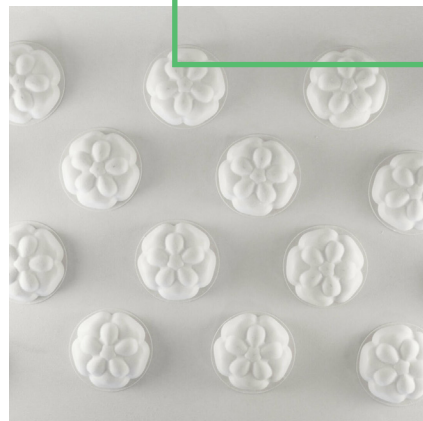

## Port of Halland

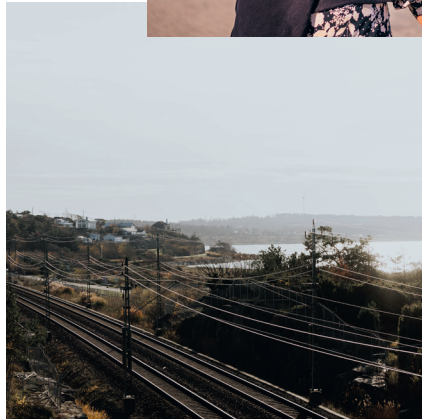

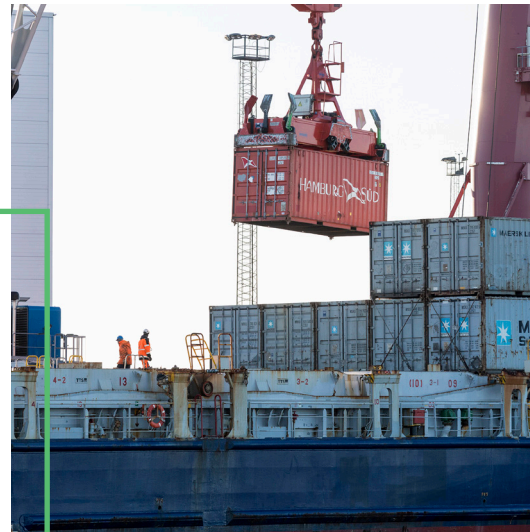

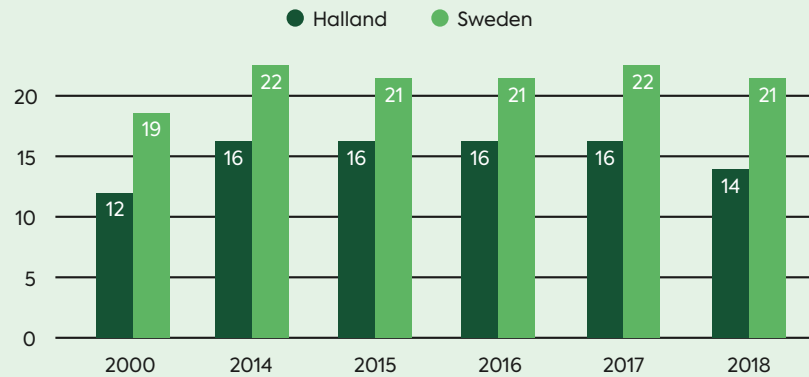

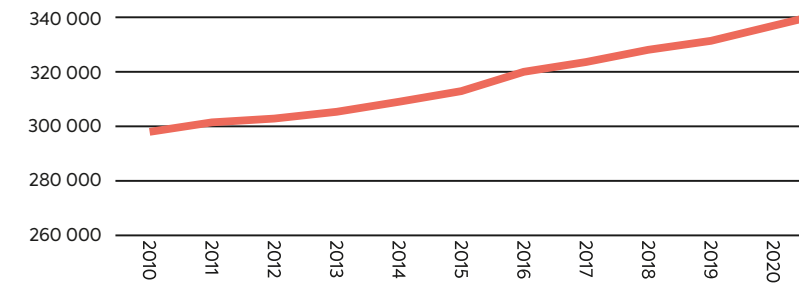

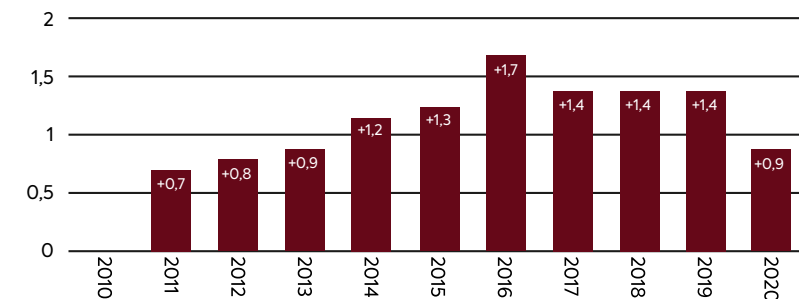

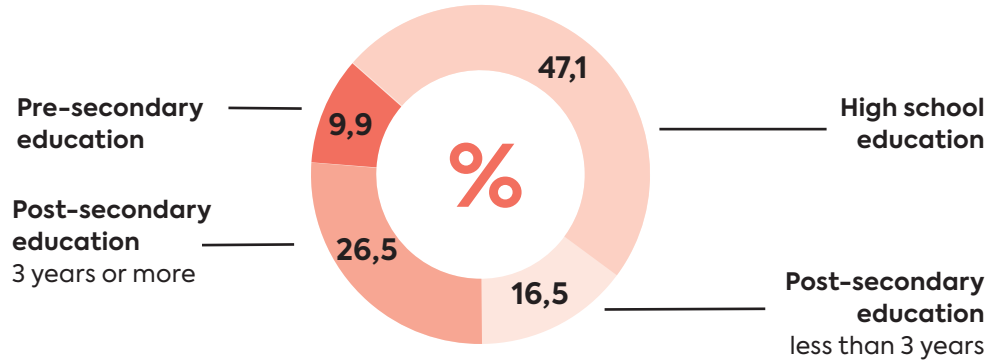

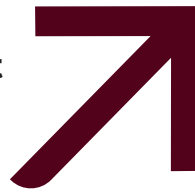

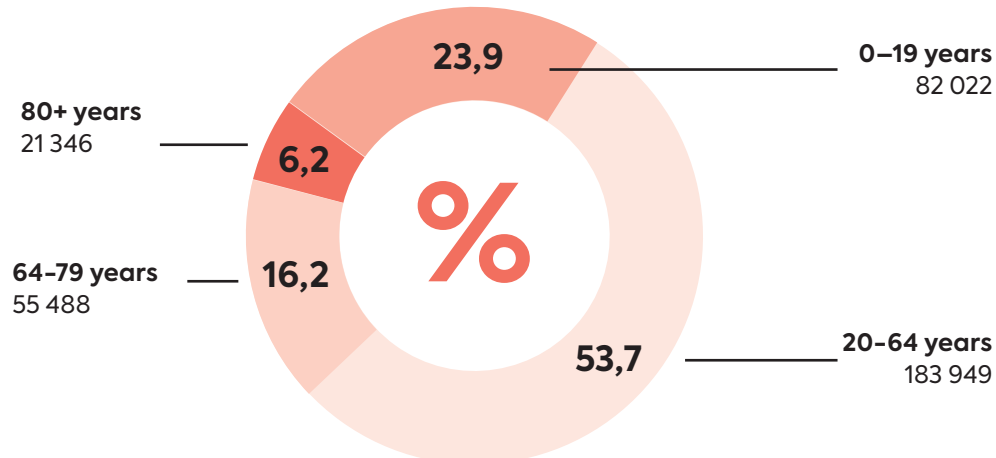

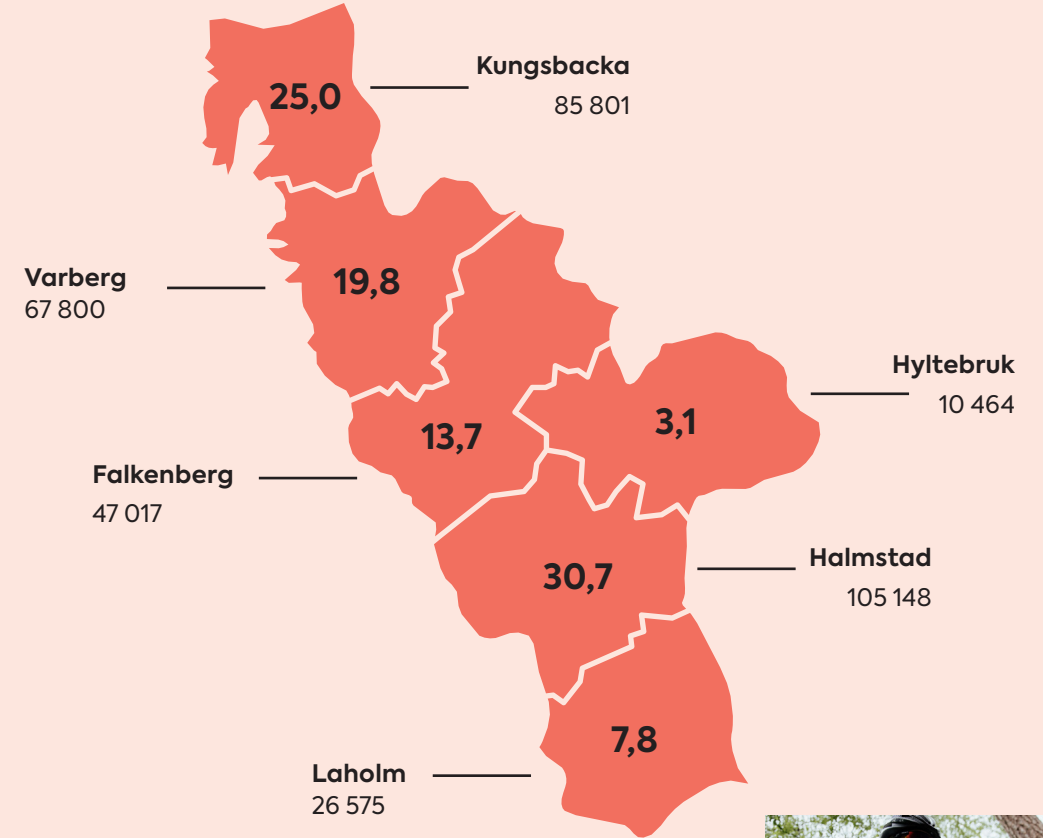

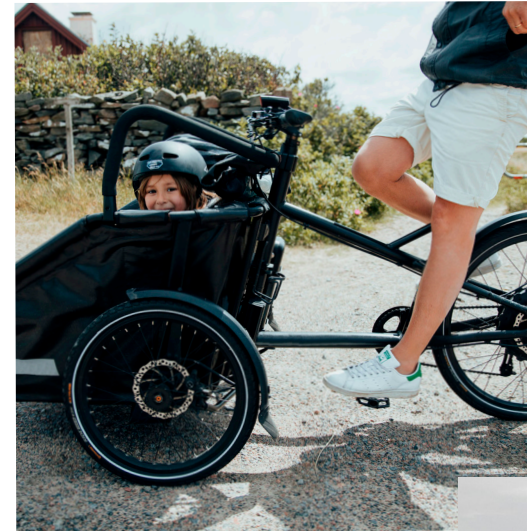

# A favorable tax climate

Favorable tax climate for both businesses and their employees. Halland has the same tax climate for businesses as the rest of Sweden. In addition, our relatively low local income taxes can be an advantage when recruiting from outside the region.

## Favorable tax climate for foreign investors

Since 2013, Sweden has become one of the most attractive places in the world for holding companies. Sweden offers more than 80 tax deals in addition to our low corporate tax. Swedish tax climate is competitive compared to other countries as well, as we have no corporate tax on interest income, distributed profits or royalties.

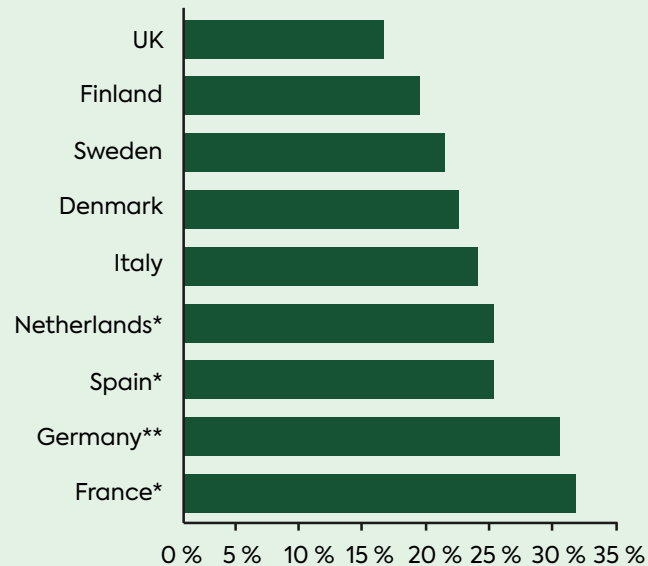
## Competitive corporate taxation

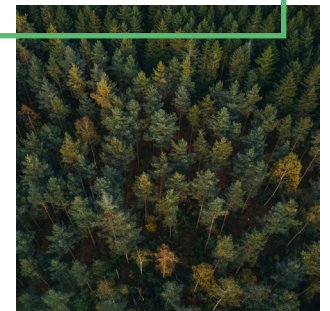

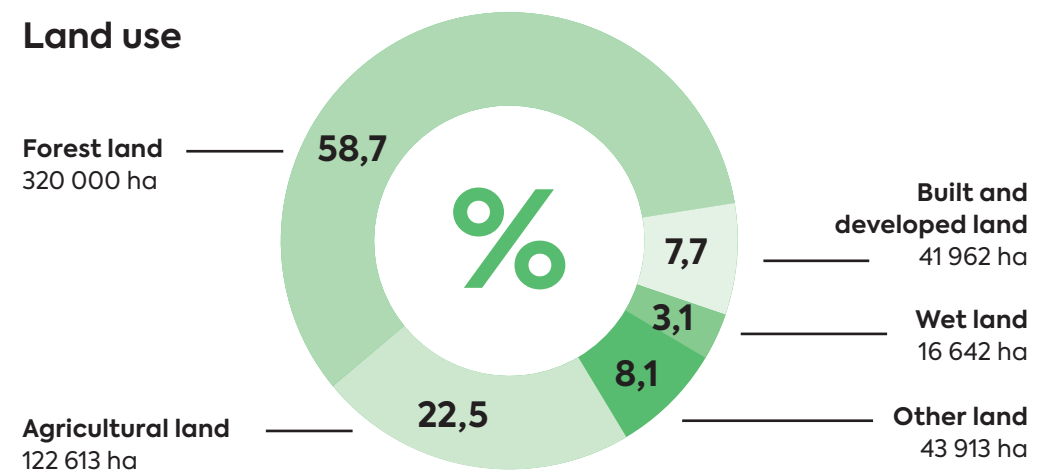
