Halland is part of multiple job markets, known for its short distances, which means convenient commuting and development opportunities. The region also boasts a well-educated population and a high population density.

#### Halland - A commuting region

Halland has strong connections to large and expanding job markets, especially with Gothenburg and Mölndal. Almost 23,000 people commute to Gothenburg and Mölndal from Halland, while 6,100 people commute to Halland from there. Additionally, there is significant commuting activity between southern Halland and Skåne.


#### **Greater Copenhagen region**
















